


# ENCOUNTER that leads to TRANSFORMATION

# Leadership Formation & Call to Form Diverse Leaders

- Basic Teachings of the Catholic Church. Modules offered twice a year
- Retreats and presentations for Ministry Leaders
- Intercultural Competency training

### Collaborative Ministry

- Bilingual Liturgies and presentations
- Engaging different cultures within the parish (deaf community, Spanish- and English-speaking members, young and older, etc.)
- Bridging parish and school ministries

### Commitment to Discipleship (to Evangelize)

- RCIA and adult Confirmation classes
- Homilies that teach the Faith
- Community engagement (speaking about the Faith at schools, colleges, and other places when invited)

### **Engage Culturally Diverse Communities**

- (As above). Presently trying to engage the large community of folks from Myanmar (Burma)
- Taking into account our diverse communities in every program, ministry and liturgy
- American Sign Language classes

## Engage Those at the Periphery of Society

- Very active Food Pantry ministry
- Cold-weather nights for the homeless, shelter for at-risk families
- Work with Austin Interfaith, focusing on just wages, immigrants, others in great need
